Each workshop begins with a Family learning experience on a Tuesday night or Sunday morning.

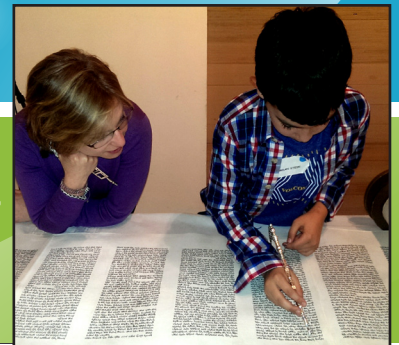
